



LEXINGTON PHILHARMONIC AUDIENCE WAIVER FOR 2022/2023 EVENTS & CONCERTS

Assumption of the Risk, and Waiver of Liability and Indemnification relating to Coronavirus/Covid

The novel coronavirus, COVID, is a worldwide pandemic according to the World Health Organization. COVID is extremely contagious in all its known forms and is believed to spread from person-to-person contact. Federal, state & local governments, and health agencies recommend social distancing, hand washing, and the wearing of masks to slow the spread of COVID.

The Lexington Philharmonic has established protocols and preventative measures to reduce the spread of COVID at any in-person events; however, LexPhil cannot guarantee anyone working at, or attending programs will not become infected with COVID, even after full vaccination. Attending any in-person program or activity may increase the risk of contracting COVID.

This waiver covers all aspects of attendance at, and/or participation in, programs presented by the Lexington Philharmonic during the 2022-2023 Season.

By attending this event, I acknowledge the contagious nature of COVID and voluntarily assume the risk that I or my children may be exposed, in relation to participating in Lexington Philharmonic programs, and that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability, and death.

I understand the risk of becoming exposed to or infected by COVID may result from the actions, omissions, or negligence of myself and others, including, but not limited to, Lexington Philharmonic, host venues, volunteers, program participants, attendees and their families.

I voluntarily agree to assume all of the foregoing risks and accept sole responsibility for any injury to myself or my children related to participation in programming presented by the Lexington Philharmonic, including, but not limited to, personal injury, disability, death, illness, damage, loss, claim, liability, or expense of any kind.

I hereby release, covenant not to sue, discharge, and hold harmless the Lexington Philharmonic, its host venues, their employees, agents, and representatives, of and from the Claims, including all liabilities, claims actions, damages, costs or expense of any kind rising out or relating thereto. I understand and agree this release includes any Claims based on the actions, omissions, or negligence of the Lexington Philharmonic, its host venues, its employees, agents and representatives, whether a COVID infection occurs before, during, or after participation in any program.
